Testimony

This is a format that can help you write out your testimony. There are four paragraphs. I have given you starters for each paragraph. You do not have use my wording, but I am just giving you starters to help you begin that paragraph. You can make this a half page or two, or however long it takes you to express what has taken place in your life.

Paragraph 1: I realized my need for Christ when...(describe how you came to the realization that you needed Christ as your Savior; what events took place, what was said that helped you realize that, maybe what did you think prior to this understanding, and what was your life like before Christ?)

Paragraph 2: I gave my life to Christ when...(describe the time and place that you gave your life to Christ. Why did you make the decision? How did you feel after the decision?)

Paragraph 3: Accepting Christ changed my life how...(talk about how your feelings or desires have changed. How has being a Christian changed you?)

Paragraph 4: Christ makes a difference in my life today how...(talk about how in your daily life being a Christian makes a difference. What is Christ doing in you life now?)

These are just helpers for you. This is just a guideline to help you. You do not have to use my outline or my wording. Just talk about how God changed you from beginning to end. If you need any help or have questions let me know!
